- The option for deposited checks appearing on your ATM receipt





INTERNATIONAL CREDIT UNION DAY COLORING WINNERS





How can I make my money resolution stick?

Be Specific About What You Want, and Why You Want It

Getting clear on your priorities and deciding on a specific goal are two keys to success. Ask yourself three "W" questions:

- What do you want to accomplish?
- When will you achieve it?
- Why does it matter to you?

Visualizing a dollar amount can lead to success, whether it is a specific figure to save, pay off, or earn in the year ahead. Keep that figure alive by writing it down or tracking it in an app. Also, give yourself a deadline that can motivate you even further.

Keep and Celebrate Milestones

Making your goal measurable will help it stick. Keeping track of your progress can help you stay focused and motivated.

Tracking progress on an app, spreadsheet, or a simple notebook helps you see your future getting closer and closer. Break your goal into smaller milestones. This makes it easier to see your progress and is less intimidating. For example, a mini-resolution might be to pay off one credit card. Making smaller changes over time is often easier than trying to make a massive change all at once.

Celebrate your success along the way. Celebrating wins actually "trains your brain" by reinforcing your new habits, which makes it easier to stay on track if you hit a bump in the road at some point.
